## Notice of Race

### 48th Annual KWCSA 'Round the Island Race, April 10, 2022 Key West, FL

1. Host: Key West Community Sailing Center (KWCSA)
2. Rules: The race will be governed by the current edition of the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and this Notice of Race, except as amended by the Sailing Instructions, which are attached and additional Sailing Instructions will be announced at the Skippers' meeting.
3. Eligibility: Fleet 1. This race is open to all classes of sailboat able to navigate under the Cow Key Channel Bridge (clearance approximately 9 feet) including, but not limited to: Laser, Laser Radial, Laser 4.7, Sunfish, 420, FJ, Sailboard, Hobie Wave. Fleet 2. All other sailboats.
4. Entry:
  - a. All entries are to be emailed to: [KWRoundIslandRace@gmail.com](mailto:KWRoundIslandRace@gmail.com). Please include your name, email address, phone number, if you have done the race before how many times and which boats you have sailed on, fleet (see para 8.) and make/model of boat you are entering this year.
  - b. If you are a KWCSA member planning to use a Community Sailing boat the requests to reserve a Center boat opens at noon on March 30. In addition to the above (Para4.a.), include make/model of first and second choice of the Center boat you are requesting. Boats will be assigned to you on a first come/first served basis based on the date and time of your email. Fleet 1 Center boats are Sunfish and Laser. All other Center boats are in Fleet 2
5. Fees: There is no entry fee for this race, donations are accepted.
6. Risk: It is the competitor's decision to enter the race and to start or continue the race. The competitors are ultimately responsible for the risks. See RRS rule 4: Decision to Race. All competitors must sign a liability waiver (available at the Skippers' meeting).
7. Schedule: Skippers' meeting 10:00 AM. Start of Race 11:00 AM. Awards ceremony will follow the race, at Schooner Wharf Bar.
8. Courses:
  - a. Fleet 1. The course will be as follows: The Start will be just outside the Garrison Bight cut, near Rat Key. The course will then go to Cow Key Channel, under the bridge, and continue West on the Atlantic side of the island, around Fort Zachary Taylor Park and North to Fleming Key North end (Garrison Bight Channel), then to the finish line off the East end of the main floating dock at the Center.
  - b. Fleet 2. The course will be as follows: The Start will be just outside the Garrison Bight cut, near Rat Key. The course will then go to North end of Fleming Key (Garrison Bight Channel). Course continues around Wisteria or Wisteria and Sunset making a figure 8 (to be announced at Skippers meeting). Then return via North end of Flemming Key to the finish line off the East end of the Center main floating dock.
9. All competitors are to follow all applicable Covid 19 protocols as outlined on the KWCSA website ([KeyWestSailingCenter.org](http://KeyWestSailingCenter.org)).
